Women in Business New Brunswick (WBNB) announces the winners of first Start Up Competition

New Brunswick – The winners of Women in Business New Brunswick's first provincial Start Up Competition were recently announced. The Competition was held in partnership with CCNB on November 30th and was part of the International W-Power project which was held on the same day in multiple locations throughout Finland and Sweden.

The competition highlighted some of the incredible women entrepreneurs from across the Province. The goal was to focus on developing an entrepreneurial mindset while providing group training workshops on subjects such as; Pricing, Buyer Persona and Making the Perfect Pitch, over a seven-week period. The participants benefited from personalized guidance as well as a one-hour consultation with a consultant.

"Due to the overwhelming interest in the competition, we decided to modify our target number of 15 participants and provide the opportunity for two cohorts to participate. We received a total of 34 applications," said Katherine Lanteigne, Director of WBNB.
